Enrolling your child at Springvale Rise Primary School can be completed in a few simple steps.

1. Ensure your child will be 5 years of age before the 30th April 2019.

4. Return the enrolment form to our office or post back the form including:

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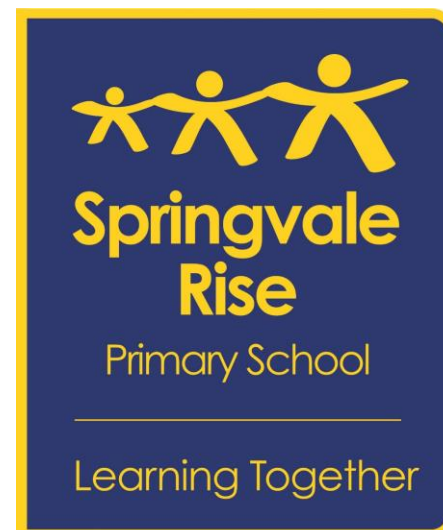

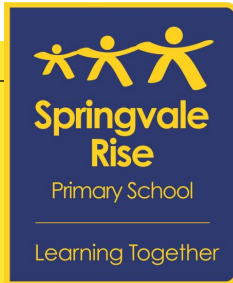
